This is making it possible for the teachers to deliver important IT training and incorporate the technology across the entire curriculum, which has an increased focus on equipping the pupils with practical skills for life.








Edward Wata has also finally received some more up-to-date technology to make his busy life that bit easier with a new mobile phone and laptop.
