#### YAWOSUP REPORT 2018 AS PRESENTED BY THE PROPGRAM OFFICER

#### INTRODUCTION

Yala widows and orphans support project is responsible for the community empowerment and the reduction of extreme poverty level within our society. It also contributes towards achievement of the vision 2030 and the sustainable development goals, which seeks to transform Kenya in to a middle income country with high quality life by 2030.

The Programs of the YAWOSUP are as follows;

- 1. Psycho social and care support.
- 2. Health care
- 3. Resource mobilization.
- 4. Life skills development.

#### MAJOR ACTIVITIES IN THE YEAR 2018

Under;

#### PSYCHOSOCIAL AND CARE SUPORT

a. WIDOWS

A proper community survey process was carried out that covered four sub units all within siriwo sub-location; i.e.

Mahoma sub-unit

-Total number of widows were 20.

- -19 of the widows were actively committed to the program
- Sadieda sub-unit

Total number of widows were 14

12 of them were actively committed to the program.

One of the widows was too old and unable to walk.

We offered a lot of counseling activities and spiritual support to each group. By bringing them together we were able to identify most of their problems and help them get them solved. This was a good platform to go through a problem solving proses.

We also encouraged them on the food security matters where some were given farm inputs e.g. fertilizers. Some also received solar lamps to be used in their homes instead of kerosene. They also went through a proper training on Group savings and loaning.

#### b. ORPHANS AND VULNERABLE CHILDREN (OVC)

This program was targeting school going youths where we were targeting the adolescent youths within our secondary schools. In 2018 we were able to work with three schools within central Gem location. E.g.;

- St. Mark, Kagilo secondary school
- St. PETER, Wagai secondary school
- St. Paul, Siriwo secondary school

The main activities offered on school outreaches were;

- Peer Youth Education
- Health talks
- Education sponsorship

The main topics covered were;

- HIV/AIDS
- Drugs and substance abuse
- Life skills development
- Communication skills
