1. Training of YAWOSUP group leaders

Currently, YAWOSUP has two clusters composed of widows' groups and caregivers' groups. We have a total of six 6 groups.

The six groups are categorized as follows:

Sawagongo Cluster -Malanga Caregivers group based in North Gem Ward

-Sawagongo Caregivers group based in Central Gem Ward

-Sawagongo Widows Self-help group based in Central Gem Ward

Ulumbi Cluster -Yala Caregivers group based in Central Gem Ward

-Yala Widows C.B.O

-Marenyo Widows Self-help group







For effective management of the groups, we trained the groups' leaders on activity implementation and financial management.

2.Repair of a widow's house

We repaired a widow's house that was almost collapsing. We thank God for the support.

3.Payment of staff salaries

YAWOSUP staff are privileged to have their salaries paid in time. This makes them work tirelessly to ensure that all the projects are implemented as planned. It is my prayer that we may increase their monthly support as a way of motivation.
